ACCESS

- 1. Download, print and place your PARKING PERMIT on your dashboard
- 2. The venue for the race village where registration (number collection), kit-check and the start/finish is at the OKKIE JOOSTE CULTURAL CENTRE
- 3. Please follow the directions of the parking marshals and signage instructions when parking, and then follow the signs and directions to Okkie Jooste for registration & kit-check.
- DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING VALUABLE IN YOUR CAR, rather bring it and leave it at bagdrop.
- 5. **NO DOGS** are allowed. There is an enormous hungry boerbull on site...

REGISTRATION & KIT CHECK

1. Registration/number collection/kit check will be open:

FRIDAY 19 May from 17h00 - 19h00 SATURDAY 20 May from 05h30 onwards

- 2. Kit check is compulsory for 38km Classic participants **ONLY**. Click <u>HERE</u> for the compulsory kit list. Plan for Weather B, any change to that will be communicated.
- 3. No kit check for the 21.5km Lite or 12.5km Aspire.
- 4. If you do not have all of the required kit, you will NOT be given your race number and will NOT be allowed to run.
- Substitutions and up/downgrades can be done during registration. A R50 substitution fee will apply.

- Aid stations are SUPPLEMENTARY and not to be used as part of your race fuelling plan.

- 2. We will have boerie rolls and pizza for sale, as well as coffee all day, of

course.

- 3. WE ARE NOT ALLOWED to sell ALCOHOL at Okkie Jooste, so please bring your own in a marked cooler box and we can place this into the walk in freezer.
- 4. Supporters are welcome and there is a swimming pool if you feel like a bracing swim to wake you up!
